



HEROES A

AND POWER-UP



Use creatures with Super (When this creature dies, if it was enchanted, return it to the battlefield under its owner's control.) and Enchant creature Auras. Power your creatures up, make them resilient to removal, and overwhelm your opponent.

Top Picks: Super Mario / Letter from the Princess / Toadette / Geno, Star Warrior / Turnip



Summon swarms of **Minions** and overwhelm your opponent, with support from the big bosses. Use **Spawn** (1: Exile this card from your hand: Create a 1/1 black Minion creature token. You may cast this card later from exile. Spawn only as a sorcery.)

early game. Pump up your tokens, or use them for sacrifice effects.

Top Picks: Bowser, King Koopa / Big World / Wendy O. Koopa / Draggadon / Fawful, Dark Keeper



Summon tricky ghosts with **Spook** (**You may cast this card face down as a 2/2 creature for 3. When this creature dies while face-down, exile it. You may cast it later from exile for its spook cost.) Gain extra benefit from killing off your face-down creatures, by casting the original spell for a reduced cost.**

Top Picks: Artistic Obsession / Boo Cloud / Professor E. Gadd / Scare-a-thon / Ghost Story



Use **Vehicle** synergies to develop your board while gaining advantage by being in **pursuit** (**You're** in **pursuit** if an **opponent controls more creatures than you.**) Crew your Vehicles with cheap, high-power creatures, and take advantage of big buffs for Vehicles only. Make sure your deck has enough ways to crew your Vehicles!

Top Picks: Parade Kart / Remote Driving / Grand Prix / Please the Crowd / Pit Crew Toad



Publish your level to become a **maker** (*If there are four or more card types among permanents you control, you're a maker for the rest of the game*) and get big bonuses. Make sure you have lots of artifacts, enchantments, and planeswalkers. Artifact creatures and enchantment creatures are a big boon.

Top Picks: Course Bot / Honey Queen / Heavy Troopa / Credits Warp / Read the Blueprints



Use permanents with "enters the battlefield" effects, then reuse them! There are a bunch of ways to get extra triggers. Build defenses early to survive, then use late-game evasion to win.

Top Picks: Starship Mario / Boo Pipes / Pipe Network / Kingfin / Shooting Star



In addition to a control strategy, gain advantage by having creatures with power 2. Face-down

Spook cards come this way, and most blue/black Vehicles can be crewed with 2 power.

Top Picks: Broozer / Eerie / Waluigi, Spite Incarnate / Spear / Tatanga, Alien Invader



Create lots of Minions and face-down Spook creatures, then sacrifice them for powerful effects. Some cards gain benefits by casting spells from exile, whether via Spook or Spawn.

Top Picks: King Bob-omb / King Kaliente / Slammer / Throne Room / Bob-omb Cannon



Attack! Use cheap aggressive creatures to win before the opponent has a chance to build up. Play flexible aggressive cards that work well both in go-wide and Super + Aura strategies.

Top Picks: Roy Koopa / Final Battle / Metal Cap / Fire Bar Roast / Iggy Koopa



Build an army of efficient creatures that are comfortable both on defense and offense. Use
Treasure token (Artifacts with "e, Sacrifice this artifact: Add one mana of any color.")
synergies to your advantage.

Top Picks: Toad Shopkeep / Bounty Board / Turn to Brick / Super Team / Mystery Block

DRAFTING MARIO: THE GATHERING

SETTING UP

- This cube can be drafted by up to eight players.
- Shuffle all 360 of the cards randomly (not the basic lands!)
- Randomly distribute three 15-card "packs" to each player facedown. Put away any remaining cards.

DRAFT NG

- Each player looks through their first pack of 15, picks a card, and passes the remaining cards to their left.
- Each player takes the cards they've been passed, picks a card, and passes the rest
- Repeat until there are no cards left to pass.
- Repeat with the second and third "packs", passing right for the second pack and left for the third pack.

BULDING A DECK

- You'll end up with 45 cards in your card pool. Using these cards, and any number of free basic lands, you must construct a 40 card deck.
- A normal deck has about 17 lands and 23 non-lands, with at least 10 creatures.
- A three-color deck tends to have a minimum of 4 multicolor mana sources.
